- 2009 Macon Chardonnay, Domaine Talmard (Maconnais) 9/ 35**
Chardonnay
Luscious, deep straw-colored wine, scents and flavors of butterscotch, honey and lemon.
- 2010 Entre-Deux-Mers, Château Moulin de Ferrand (Bordeaux) 9/ 35**
Sauvignon Blanc, Semillon
Dry, with citrus and exotic fruit notes
- 2010 Vouvray, Dom. des Aubusieres, 'cuvée de Silex 10/39**
Chenin Blanc
Nose of Honeysuckle and melon lead into balanced minerality and citrus rind
- 2009 Rosé, Chateau Bas (Provence) 9/ 35**
Mourvedre, Cinsault, Grenache
Dry with concentrated fruits.

- 2009 Louis Latour Domaine de Valmoissine (Bourgogne) 9/35**
Pinot Noir
Intense ripe red fruit nose and palate. Subtle tannins.
- 2008 Côtes-du-Rhone Village, Felix Ravinet (Rhône) 11/42**
Grenache, Syrah, Cinsault
Fresh, fruity and elegant character. Red currant and raspberry aromas, hint of spice
- 2006 Les collines , Domaine Ollier taillefer (Languedoc) 10/ 39**
Carignan,Grenache,Shirah
fresh red fruits, dominated by raspberry and cherry, full and round on the palate with silky tannins and a smooth finish accented with spices.
- 2009 Bordeaux Superieur, Château Jalousie (Bordeaux) 11/42**
Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon
Medium bodied, cassis and plum and subtle spice.

- NV Jaillance, Brut Rosé (Crémant de Bordeaux) 9/38**
Merlot
A rich, lustrous salmon-pink color with elegant bubbles. Delightful bouquet with aromas of red fruit (raspberry and redcurrant) and a fresh hint of menthol.
- NV Nicolas Feuillatte, Brut (Champagne) 15/57**
Pinot Noir & Meunier ,Chardonnay
A pale gold moire color, a slightly fruity nose, a subtle predominance of white fruits.
- NV Billecart-Salmon, Brut Rosé (Champagne) 165**
Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier, Chardonnay
Tangerine, pear, and flowers on the nose, with a hint of fennel. Dry, with lively orange and strawberry flavors, followed by a subtle note of spice cake. 90RP
- NV Veuve Cliquot, Brut (Champagne) 119/ 60 half btl**
Pinot Noir & Meunier ,Chardonnay
Almond, honey and ginger flavors; appealing texture, firm finish.
- 2002 Dom Pérignon, Brut (Champagne) 219**
Pinot Noir & Chardonnay -96 RP
With a fullness in the mouth, its earthy, smoky, pearly complexity rises to the surface, underscored by the vibrant warmth of peppery spice.
- 1998 Henriot, Brut "Cuvée des Enchanteleurs" (Champagne) 230**
Pinot Noir & Chardonnay
Like finely woven silk, this offers beautiful texture, sublime balance and integration. 97WS
- NV Henriot, Brut (Champagne) 70**
Pinot Noir & Chardonnay
Flavors of green apples and fresh apricot. Extremely fresh and dry and rich. 94 WE

- 2009 Chassagne-Montrachet, Jean Noel Gagnard 190**
floral with hints of white orchard fruit, resin and a light touch of minerality that carries over to the rich and relatively full-bodied flavors yet the finish remains cool, clean and quite dry.-92 BH
- 2005 Beaune du Château, Premier Cru, Bouchard 82**
Chardonnay
Elegant bouquet of flowers and fruit , with light vanilla note. 88BH
- 2008 Meursault "les Narvaux", Remi Jobard 95**
Chardonnay
Nose of toast, pear and acacia blossom frame floral and citrus palate. 88BH
- 2009 Chablis, Domaine William Fevre, Champs Royaux 41**
Chardonnay
Fresh nose of minerals, sea breeze, and citrus blossom. Clean crisp finish. 87BH

2009 Pouilly-Fuissé, Bouchard Père & Fils 48
Chardonnay
A complex nose offers notes of straw, melon and citrus where the latter continues onto the rich, generous and rather fleshy medium-bodied flavors that possess good dry extract levels and fine finishing intensity.

2009 Bourgogne, Olivier Larochette 42
Chardonnay
Sharp attack, with citrus and floral qualities

VALLEE DE LA LOIRE

2010 Sancerre, Henri Bourgeois 49
Sauvignon Blanc
Gorgeous floral nose, intense citrus and balanced minerality.

2009 Reuilly, Claude Lafond 38
Sauvignon Blanc
Very rich aromas of lemon and grapefruit. Good balance.

2010 Pouilly Fumé, Serge Dagueneau & Filles "Les Pentes" 47
Sauvignon Blanc
Dry palate with flavors of white melon, touch of caraway seed, and chalky minerality. Good acidity, long, crisp, clean, dry finish.

2009 Chinon, Couly-Dutheil, 'Les Chanteaux' 44
Chenin Blanc
Intense and fresh, very aromatic. Floral, aromatic nose of papaya, grasses and soft minerals. Round and fresh palate of melon, peach and almond. 90WS

2010 Muscadet sur Lie, Domaine de la Pepière 37
Muscadet
Scented with green apple, lime, quarry dust, and a hint of elder flower

ALSACE, SAVOIE & RHONE

2010 Côte du Rhône Blanc, Eric Texier (Rhône) 35
Grenache,
Rich, deep and concentrated with lots of floral notes, round, generous flavors, crisp acidity.

2006 Pinot Gris, Trimbach, Reserve Pinot Gris (Alsace) 39
Textured and bright, with a hint of fresh mushroom framing the pear and peach notes.

2006 Riesling, Paul Kubler (Alsace)
Full bodied, intense floral and peach notes, nice minerality

2010 Apremont, (Vin de Savoie) 36
Jacquere
Crisp, fresh, light and elegant with flavors of ripe apple and melon.

PROVENCE

2008 Bandol Blanc, La Bastide Blanche 41
Mourvedre, Clairette, Bourleblanc
Peach, golden delicious apple, and pear. Zesty, spicy finish.

2010 Côtes de Provence Rosé, Andrieux & Fils, Cuvee Victoria 38
Grenache, Syrah
Salmon colored with raspberry and strawberry aromas. Well balanced mouth is highlighted by apricots and white peaches. Refreshing and lingering finish.

2010 Bandol Rosé, La Bastide Blanche 41
Cinsault, Grenache, Mourvedre
Pale pink, with flavors of red berry, citrus and spice.

LES ETATS UNIS

2008 Elk Cove, Willamette Valley (WA) 36
Pinot Blanc
Bouquet of mineral, apple, and white peach. Crisp, vibrant, and spicy

2007 L'Ecole N° 41, Columbia Valley (WA) 34
Semillon
Rich fruit and balanced acidity. Fragrant citrus, floral aromas and a mineral rich finish.

2009 Chinook Winery, Yakima Valley (WA) 41
Chardonnay
White peaches dusted with cinnamon and hints of tea, honey and candied apricot.

2010 Harbinger Winery, Dynamo White, "Le Petite Fleur" (WA) 35
Chardonnay, Pinot Gris, Riesling
Intensely aromatic bouquet followed by invigorating fruit and acidit

LES VINS ROUGES BOURGOGNE (Pinot Noir)

- 2007 Charmes-Chambertin Grand Cru, Sérafin Père & Fils 340**
Dark wild berries, violet, licorice and underbrush on the nose. Sweet, lush and deep. Densely packed flavors of wild berries and chocolate. Finishes broad and very ripe, with suave, fine-grained tannins and lingering subtle perfume. 93BH
- 2005 Pommard, Domaine Parent, 1er cru, Les Chaeponières 109**
Wide ranging bouquet with red fruit and spicy hints. Highly flavoured, with great finesse.
- 2008 Nuits St.-Georges "Les St.-Georges" 1er Cru 112**
Powerful, medium-full bodied. Spiced red berry nose, firm tannins 94BH
- 2009 Côte De Nuits Village, Frédéric Magnien, Croix-Violette 69**
Captivating aromas of purple roses, baking spices and plenty of red berries on the nose. 89BH
- 2009 Maranges, Michel Sarrazin et fils 55**
Notes of cinnamon and clove mix with bass notes of licorice with hints of dried roses and plenty of black pepper. More spice and saturated red and black fruits dominate the mouth, with a stunningly silky mouthfeel and good freshness.

BEAUJOLAIS (Gamay)

- 2009 Moulin A Vent, Les Trois Roches, Domaine du Vissoux 45**
Dark cherry and purple plum nose. Smoky, crushed stone, and saline mineral elements interchange with concentrated food. 91RP
- 2008 Beaujolais-Village, Albert Bichot 39**
Spicy with cherry and strawberry notes. Light and easy drinking

VALLEE DU RHONE NORTHERN RHONE (Syrah)

- 2007 Côte-Rôtie, Jean-Michel Gerin 98**
Medium bodied, notes of green and black olives, intermixed with licorice, smoked herbs, red currants, and cassis
- 2005 Saint Joseph, cave de train 41**
warm and pleasant texture, with notes of cherry and violet.

SOUTHERN RHONE

- 2009 Gigondas, Saint-Damien 69**
Grenache, Mourvèdre, Syrah
notes of crushed rock, boysenberry, black raspberry, camphor, and a hint of pen ink. -93 RP
- 2009 Vacqueyras, Andrieux & Fils, Cuvée André 44**
Grenache, Syrah, Mourvedre
Deep ruby color with violet scents and plum aromas. Notes of cherry and black currant, sandalwood and light spices. 90 WS
- 2009 Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Domaine Raymond Usseglio & Fils 86**
Grenache, Mourvedre, Syrah, Cinsault, Counoise
medium to full-bodied, displaying loads of kirsch, pepper, garrigue and earth notes. -90RP
- 2008 Cairanne, Dom. Alary, "La Font d'Estevenas" 45**
Grenache, Syrah
evolved bouquet of flowers, black raspberries, and roasted Provençal herbs, medium to full-bodied, fleshy flavors, and an irresistible, endearing finish. 91RP
- 2008 Constant-Duquesnoy, Vinsobres 49**
Grenache, Syrah
Aromas of pepper, spring flowers, roasted herbs. medium to full bodied. -90RP

PROVENCE, SOUTHWEST & LOIRE

- 2005 Saumur Champigny, Château de Targé (Loire) 41**
Cabernet Franc
Medium to full bodied and dry flavors of plum, raspberries and spice
- 2006 Cahors, Dom. La Berangerie, Cuvée Maurin (Southwest) 39**
Malbec
Ripe cassis and elderberry fill the nose.
- 2007 Bandol, La Bastide Blanche, cuvee Estagnol (Provence) 54**
Mourvedre, Grenache
Soft tannins, notes of cassis and black cherry.
- 2009 Corbieres, Las Vals Les Pins Rouge (southwest) 49**
Mourvedre, Grenache, Carignan
Perfumey nose of black cherry, anise, spice and mineral, with a touch of coffee.
- 2009 Côtes du Rousillon Villages, Domaine Gauby (Southwest) 45**
Grenache, Syrah
Spicy and fresh with cherry, chocolate and raspberry flavors.

BORDEAUX

RIGHT BANK (Merlot, Cab, Cab Franc)

- 2006 St. Emilion Grand Cru, Château Jean Faure 105**
Lively aromas of currant, dark cherry and tobacco, flavors of plum, dark chocolate, smoke and minerals. 92 Stephen Tanzer
- 2004 Côtes De Bordeaux, Château Carignan 45**
Black currant and violet notes on the nose, with a good dose of slightly charred oak.
- 2005 Côtes de Castillon, Chateau la Brande 49**
Rustic style, with dark fruits and earthy notes.
- 2005 Côtes De Bourg, cru bourgeois, Château Rousselle 55**
Nose of spice, ripe fruits and dried herbs. Well balanced with firm tannins.
- 2005 Canon-Fronsac, Château Moulin Pey-Labrie 92 RP 75**
Licorice, sweet red and black fruit, spice and stone scents lead to a round, full bodied wine

LEFT BANK (Cab, Merlot)

- 2003 Saint-Julien, Ducru-Beaucaillou, Grand Cru 96 RP 340**
Powerful and tannic. Jammy crème de cassis, raspberry, and flower characteristics intertwined with notes of earth, mineral and oak. Tremendous definition 96RP
- 2003 Saint-Estephe, Château De Pez, Cru Bourgeois Exceptionnel 66**
Spicy, soft, savory, medium to full-bodied, with a dark ruby/plum color, hints of earth, plum, and black currant fruit are present
- 2006 Haut-Medoc, Château Caronne Ste. Gemme 49**
Lots of berry and chocolate character with hints of vanilla. Full-bodied, with a solid core of fruit and bold tannins.
- 2006 Pauillac, Château Puy La Rose, Medoc 59**
Medium bodied, aromas of red berries and fruit. velvety, smooth tannins, long finish.
- 2007 Moulis-en-Médoc, Château Dutruch, Grand Poujeaux 52**
Dark red, good fleshy fruit, good length
- 2005 Margaux, Château Monbrison 97**
Deep ruby hue, notes of sweet cherries, roasted herbs, licorice, and gamy meat and attractively textured.
- 2005 Pessac-Leognan Château de Cruzeau, Grave 64**
Dense upfront, coffe and ripe fruit. good tanning Licorice finish.

LES ETATS UNIS

- 2008 L'Ecole N° 41, Columbia Valley, (WA) 42**
 Merlot
Nose of spicebox, violets, cassis, cedar and black cherry. Medium bodied.
- 2008 Harbinger Winery, Cabernet Franc (WA) 48**
 Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot
Medium to full bodied, fruit forward, highlighted by blackberry. Finish of red berries, spice and hints of chocolate
- 2007 Forgeron Cellars, Columbia Valley, (WA) 53**
 Cabernet Sauvignon
Full bodied with aromas of blackberry, currants and hint of anise. Balanced acidity.
- 2009 Waters Winery, Interlude, Columbia Valley, (WA) 58**
 Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc
Flavors of red cherry, black currants, chocolate and Minerals. Soft tannins, balanced.
- 2007 Belle Pente Vinyards, Yamhill Valley, (OR) 68**
 Pinot Noir
Very expressive, with heady aromas of dark red and blue fruits, accented by herbs and woodsmoke. Focused palate with good underlying structure and perfect acid/tannin structure.

DEMIS (Half Bottles) WHITE

- 2009 Sancerre, Henri Bourgeois (Loire) 28**
 Sauvignon Blanc
Gorgeous, intense citrus and balanced minerality.
- 2007 Chablis, Domaine William fevre (Burgundy) 25**
 Chardonnay
well-articulated fruit and excellent overall balance. Bright citrus notes weave through the long, clean finish

RED

- 2007 Torii Mor, Willamette Valley (Oregon) 27**
 Pinot Noir
Dark berries, cherries, earth and spice. Rich and mouth-filling with structured tannins.
- 2006 1er Côtes de Blaye, Château Gigault, "Cuvée Viva" (Bordeaux) 25**
 Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon
Aromas of cassis, licorice, flowers and spices. Suave and energetic, with a peppery quality and brisk acidity nicely buffered by fruit.
